For over 27 years, Dr. Tony Baron has studied the impact of power on people, organizations, communities and societies. In 1993, Dr. Baron founded Baron Center, Incorporated, a San Diego-based consulting firm hailed for pioneering violence prevention programs.

His research led to the publication of Violence in the Workplace: A Prevention and Management Guide (1993), and When Work Equals Life: The Next Stage of Workplace Violence (2000).

Dr. Baron counseled survivors of the Oklahoma City bombing of the Murrah Building in 1995, the Columbine High School massacre in 1999, as well as survivors from the September 11, 2001, attack on The World Trade Center. In 2009, while serving as President of The Servant Leadership Institute in Vista, California, he published a book on leadership: *The Art of Servant Leadership* (2010), a compelling case study of leadership tested by adversity.

As Scholar in Residence at Center for Executive Excellence, Dr. Baron inspires and develops leaders to achieve results without compromising dignity. Dr. Baron previously served as Professor of Leadership & Formation at Azusa Pacific University's Graduate School. He holds a double doctorate in psychology and theology and has completed post-doctoral continuing education work at Harvard Medical School. He is Board Certified in Forensic Medicine and is a diplomate in the American Board of Psychological Specialties.
